


If a student has completed modules and has been active through the course, then the students activity feed will be populated with the students activities throughout the course and modules. Activity Feed Available Tasks






The student can select the course from the list of courses assigned to him/her and begin the course from the next step.

MODULE INFORMATION






The course information will be displayed as well as the modules for the course, the student progress, the duration, facilitator and the students course status.

START SECTION









The student will be directed to the question of the assessment.


The question and answer space is available. Once answered. The student can click on submit to go to the next question.


